Awareness and preparation can make all the difference to the safety and security of your staff, volunteers and premises



## Understanding community and premises vulnerabilities

- Have an assessment of your premises conducted by local authorities
- Consult your community about their concerns and experiences



## Maintain pre-existing security solutions

- Regularly check security devices and solutions for disrepair
- Budget for new measures and repairs when possible
- Train new staff to use pre-existing security elements



## Maintaining awareness

- Use the Faith Guardian Forum to learn about latest trends
- Connect with other communities and local authorities to exchange relevant information
- Conduct regular meetings with your staff to offer threat updates



## Pursue and offer training to ensure staff can

- Recognise vulnerabilities
- Identify threats
- Follow security protocol
- Use safety tools effectively
- Respond to incidents appropriately
